The status on Progress of mine-wise Mine Closure Activities carried out by the Mine Operator for **Q.E. June 2017** needs to submit this office within **15th July, 2017**.



Monitoring System for Mine Closure Activities based on Different Milestones and Timeframes as per Mine Closure Plan.

1. Every Mine Owner shall submit a Quarterly as well as Yearly Report to CCO regarding mine closure activities as per the given format till the online system is introduced. After introduction of the online system, they will feed the data online.
2. CCO will compile the data as received from the mine owners and will scrutinize the same.
3. CCO will also inspect the mines as and when required for checking the mine closure activities as per the approved MCP.
4. If required, Government approved agencies may also be asked to conduct verification of mine closure activities of a mine or number of mines and submit report to this office. Cost of such study shall be borne by the concerned mine owner(s).
5. Based on the data received, compiled and scrutinized and also based on the inspection report, CCO will submit a consolidated data to the Ministry on regular interval and also as and when required.
